This round table session draws on case studies to show that well-designed collaborations give girls authentic opportunities to develop character and leadership.

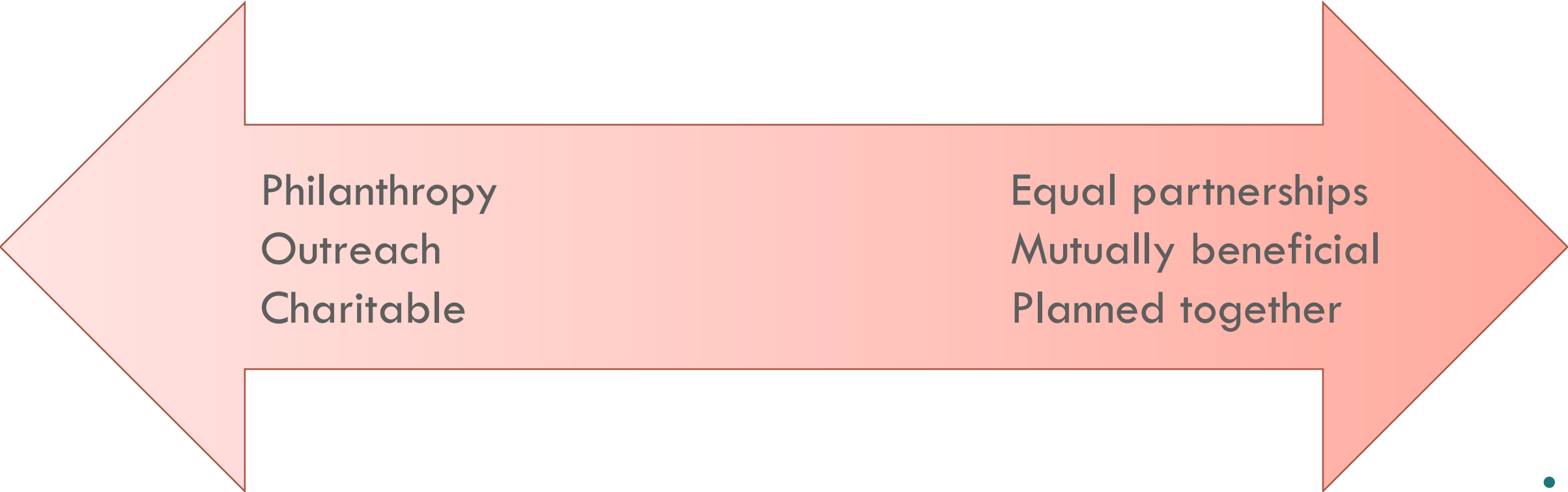

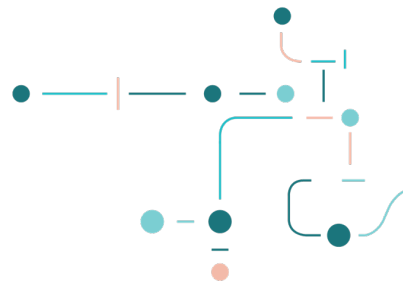
Channing School cookery club: MEASURING IMPACT

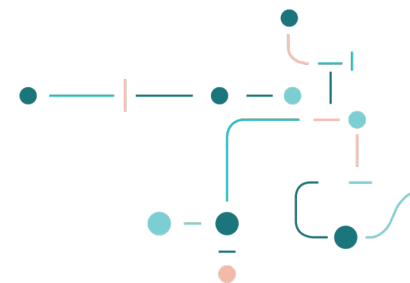

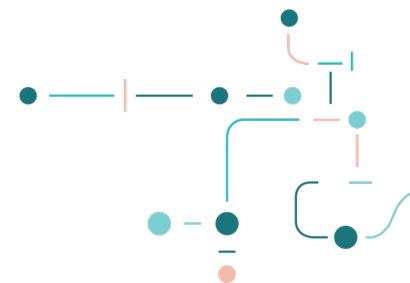

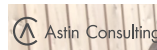
